# Genuine Toyota Parts

To safeguard the quality, reliability and value of your vehicle, Toyota recommends using only Genuine Toyota Parts for maintenance and repairs. Like all Toyota products, Genuine Toyota Parts are built to the highest standards of quality and performance. They are also designed to fit your vehicle's exact specifications.

Your Toyota Dealership has Genuine Toyota Parts to meet your vehicle service needs. And because it is linked electronically to Toyota's Parts Distribution Centres, the dealership has quick access to any parts it may not have in stock.

Genuine Toyota Parts are warranted for 12 months (regardless of kilometres travelled) or for the remainder of any applicable New Vehicle Warranty, whichever is longer. Non-Genuine Toyota Parts, and any damage or failures resulting from their use, are not covered by Toyota Warranty.

For all your maintenance and repair needs, insist on the quality and peace of mind you get with Genuine Toyota Parts.





When you want to personalise your Toyota vehicle, be sure to do it without sacrificing Toyota quality and performance. How? By choosing Genuine Toyota Accessories.

Genuine Toyota Accessories are designed and manufactured specifically for Toyota vehicles. In addition, they undergo rigorous testing to ensure first-rate quality, precise fit and long-term durability. Aftermarket accessories do not always meet these same high standards.

The quality of Genuine Toyota Accessories is also backed by the integrity of a Toyota warranty. If Genuine Toyota Accessories are fitted at the time of new Vehicle purchase, they are warranted for the duration of the new vehicle warranty of 3 years or 100,000 km whichever occurs first. If the accessories are fitted after new vehicle purchase, they are warranted for the remainder of the new vehicle warranty or for 12 months, whichever is the longer. And remember that Genuine Toyota Accessories can be purchased from an authorised Toyota Dealer.



### **Important Notice**

The benefits conferred by this warranty are in addition to all other rights and remedies in respect of such vehicle which the owner has under the Trade Practices Act (Commonwealth) and other State and Territory laws.

#### **Definitions**

#### **Warranty Commencement Date**

The Warranty Commencement Date means the date the vehicle is either:

- (a) delivered to its first owner, or
- (b) first put into service by Toyota or an authorised Toyota Dealer as a company or demonstration vehicle,

whichever date is the earlier.

#### Warranty Repair

Warranty Repair means a repair performed during the Warranty Period under the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty to rectify a defect caused by faulty materials and or workmanship at the time of vehicle manufacture.

#### **Maintenance Service**

Maintenance Service means the regular inspections, adjustments, changes of oils, coolant, fluids and lubricants, and the regular replacement of expendable items, necessary due to the passage of time and or the accumulation of kilometres travelled by the vehicle.

### **Warranty Period**

#### **Warranty Commencement Date**

The "Warranty Commencement Date" is shown on the "New Vehicle Information Statement" on the inside front cover of this booklet.

#### **Vehicle Warranty**

This warranty applies to all new Toyota vehicles sold in Australia for 3 years or 100,000 kilometres, whichever occurs first, from the "Warranty Commencement Date".

#### **Paint Defect and Surface Rust**

Paint defect or surface rust is warranted for 3 years or 100,000 kilometres, whichever occurs first, from the "Warranty Commencement Date".

#### **Corrosion Perforation Warras**

This warranty is in addition to the "Vehicle Warranty" and applies for 5 years unlimited kilometres from the "Warranty Commencement Date".

#### **Accessory Warranty**

Genuine Toyota accessories fitted at the time of new vehicle purchase are warranted for the duration of the new vehicle warranty 3 years or 100,000 km, whichever occurs first. If the accessories are fitted after new vehicle burchase, they are warranted for the remainder of the new vehicle warranty or for 12 months, whichever is the longer.

#### What is Covered

#### **Vehicle Warranty**

Toyota warrants that within the warranty period it will repair or replace free of charge any Toyota components (except those items listed under "What is Not Covered") installed in your vehicle as original equipment found to be defective in materials or workmanship under normal use and operation in Australia.

#### **Paint Defect and Surface Rust**

Any paint defect or surface rust appearing on any of the painted body panels is warranted for the duration of the warranty period, except in those instances listed under "What is Not Covered".

For information on how to protect your vehicle from corrosion, see "Corrosion Prevention and Appearance Care" in the Owner's Manual.

#### **Corrosion Perforation Warranty**

Toyota warrants that within the warranty period it will repair or replace any original body panel that develops perforation from corrosion (rust-through), except in those instances listed under "What is Not Covered".

#### **Accessory Warranty**

Genuine Toyota Accessories are warranted against defect for the duration of the warranty period, except in those instances listed under "What is Not Covered".

#### **Towing**

Where a warranted part has failed, and the vehicle is inoperative or unsafe to drive, towing of a vehicle to the nearest authorised Toyota Dealer is covered under the terms and conditions of this warranty. Refer to "Question 2" page 13 for arther details.

#### Battery

During the first 12 months of service, regardless of kilometres travelled, a defective original equipment battery will be replaced free of charge. Should the battery fail during the second 12 months of service, 50% of the replacement cost will be covered by the warranty.

#### What is Not Covered

#### General

Under normal circumstances, no responsibility will be accepted where a part has required repair or replacement as a direct or indirect result of:

- the failure by a non-Toyota repairer, owner or operator to follow the manufacturer's recommendations; or
- the use of non-genuine Toyota parts or accessories; or
- the faulty workmanship, default or negligence of a non-Toyota repairer.

#### **Tyres**

The Toyota New Vehicle Warranty does not cover tyres. They are covered by the tyre manufacturer's warranty.

# Factors Beyond the Manufacturer's Control Including but Not Limited to:

Repairs required as a result of misuse (racing, overloading, etc.), negligence, water incress, modification, alteration, tampering, disconnection, improper adjustment or repairs, accident, parts not supplied by Toyota, and the use of add-on parts or materials are not covered.

- Cosmetic or surface corrosion from stone chips or scratches in the paint are not covered.
- Damage or surface corrosion from the environment such as activatin, airborne fall-out (chemicals, tree sap, etc.) salt, hail, windstorms, lightning, floods, or otherlike acts are not covered.
  - Incidental and consequential damages such as telephone calls, car rental charges, hotel bills, loss of income or time, inconvenience or commercial loss are not covered.

### Lack of Maintenance Service or Use of Incorrect Fuel, Oils, Lubricants, Coolant or Fluids Including but Not Limited to:

Repairs caused by improper maintenance, lack of Maintenance Service and the use of other than the fuel, oils, lubricants, coolant or fluids specified in the Owner's Manual are not covered.

# Maintenance Service or Expendable Parts Including but Not Limited to:

Engine tune-up, lubrication, cleaning and polishing, replacement of filters, coolant, spark plugs, fuses, worn wiper blades, worn brake pads, linings and clutch linings are some of the normal Maintenance Services required by all vehicles.

# Normal Noise, Vibration and Deterioration Including but Not Limited to:

Normal noise, vibration, wear and tear, and deterioration such as discolouration, flaking, deformation or blur are not covered.

#### **Altered Odometer**

Failure of a vehicle in which the odometer has been altered, tampered with or defaced so that the number of kilometres travelled by the vehicle cannot be readily ascertained is not covered.

#### **Odometer Change Record**

If at any time it becomes necessary for a new odometer to be installed in your vehicle, please have your Toyota Dealer record the date of the change and the kilometres shown on the original odometer below.

### **Owner's Responsibilities**

- You must present this booklet to any authorised
   Toyota Dealer whenever Warranty Repair is required.
- You must deliver the vehicle to any authorised
   Toyota Dealer in order to obtain the Warranty Repair.
- You must properly operate, maintain and care for your Toyota in accordance with the instructions contained herein and in the Owner's Manual.
- When you change your name and or address, you are requested to complete the "Owner Information Change Form" in this booklet and return it to Toyota as outlined. Likewise, new owners of the Toyota vehicle are also requested to complete the form.

### **Answers to Some Typical Questions**

To help you understand the New Vehicle Warranty for your Toyota, the following provides answers to some typical questions.

#### Question 1

How do I get my vehicle repaired or checked if it malfunctions during the warranty period?

#### **Answer**

All new Toyota vehicles are covered by warranty.

Should you want to arrange for work to be carried out on your Toyota, or should you want to discuss a Warranty Repair or Maintenance Service problem, follow the seps given below, in the sequence listed, for the fastest possible response.

#### Talk to Your Toyota Dealer

This is the most direct way to solve your problem. Every Toyota Dealer is ultimately responsible for providing the Warranty Repair you may need, and has the knowledge, tools and resources available to keep your Toyota in top condition.

First, talk to the Dealer Service Advisor or Customer Relations Manager, explaining the problem fully.

Then, if you feel that your problem has not been resolved or that your questions have not been answered, ask to see the Service Manager.

If, after that, you feel you would like more information, ask to discuss the matter with the Dealer's Owner or General Manager. Since it is their business, they will be most interested in your continued patronage.

#### Question 2

What do I do in an emergency if my vehicle breaks down and Warranty Repair is required but there is not a Toyota Dealer nearby to supply such a service?

#### **Answer**

Should such a situation arise, first check the "Toyota Dealer Directory" in this booklet and contact the nearest Toyota Dealer to your location for advice. If the Dealer cannot be contacted, then ring the Toyota Customer Relations Centre on the toll-free telephone number: 1800 252 097, or 9710 3955 within the Sydney metropoli area.

If a Toyota Dealer or the Toyota Customer Relations Centre cannot be contacted and, in an emergency, a repair or replacement of a type which normally would be covered by the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty is necessary to enable the vehicle to be operated safely, the Warranty Repair may be carried out by a suitably qualified repairer.

# Do not make any attempt to drive your vehicle if it is unsafe to do so.

At the earliest possible time after the repair, you must take your vehicle to your Toyota Dealer, or to the nearest Toyota Dealer to the breakdown, for inspection and further Warranty Repair if it is felt necessary by that Dealer.

Also, at the time of inspection, you must present the invoice for the emergency repair so that a claim for the reasonable cost may be made by the Dealer. See "Toyota New Vehicle Warranty" in this booklet for more details.

If this is not possible, please send your claim to the Toyota Service Manager in your state (see "State Distributor" in the "Toyota Dealer Directory" for address details) and ensure that the following information is included:

- Name/s of the selling and servicing Toyota Dealers.
- Full address of the emergency repairer.
- Odometer reading at the time of the emergency repair and at the time of making the claim.
- All vehicle particulars given on the inside front cover of this booklet.
- A full explanation of the reason for the emergency repair.

#### Question 3

Will the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty apply if my vehicle is used to tow a caravan or trailer?

#### Answer

Your vehicle may be used for towing a carayan or trailer and be covered by warranty providing:

 Your Toyota is serviced correctly and regularly according to the "Toyota Maintenance Schedule" in this booklet.

- That any towing modifications specified for your vehicle by Toyota have been correctly installed.
   Contact your Toyota Dealer for further information.
- The towing equipment is properly installed.
- That you adhere to the instructions for the use and operation of the towing equipment fitted to your vehicle including any instructions on the use and operation of any other recommended equipment.

The vehicle, caravan or trailer weights do not exceed those specified for your vehicle in the State or Territory in which the combination is to operate.

Regulations and requirements vary so if you have any doubts regarding the caravan or trailer you propose to tow, consult the appropriate motoring organisation.

- Your vehicle is driven and operated properly, carefully, and at speeds at which it and the caravan or trailer can be safely controlled.
- Your vehicle and caravan or trailer is not overloaded.

Further, all owners should remember that towing a caravan or trailer can have an adverse effect on stability, safety, durability and operating economy of your vehicle. Such problems will largely be overcome if the towing equipment, loads and vehicle operation are as recommended by Toyota.

There are many factors that can affect stability, safety, durability and operating economy. Such things as caravan or trailer shape, as well as trailer and vehicle loading, can cause problems. However, if the caravan or trailer being towed is the correct size and weight, not overloaded and is within the operating capacity of your vehicle, your vehicle is not overloaded, and is operated properly and carefully at speeds at which it and the caravan or trailer can be safely controlled, the adverse effects of towing can be minimised.

#### Question 4

Are Toyota parts and accessories covered by a warranty?

#### **Answer**

Yes, gentine Toyota parts and accessories obtained from a Toyota Dealer are warranted against defects in factory materials or poor workmanship. See "Toyota New Vehicle Warranty" in this booklet for more details.

#### Question 5

If my vehicle is with a Toyota Dealer receiving a Warranty Repair, are out of pocket expenses such as accommodation, travel or commercial loss included in the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty?

#### **Answer**

The Toyota New Vehicle Warranty covers repair or replacement of parts that are defective in materials or workmanship at the Toyota Dealer premises. It does not cover claims for compensation.

#### Question 6

What costs are not covered by the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty?

#### Answer

Labour, parts or lubricants used in the provision of Maintenance Service and normal maintenance of parts, for example, spark plugs, filter, brake and clutch linings, except where parts are found to be defective or any other item that has been the subject of wear and tear. See "Toyota New Vehicle Warranty" in this booklet for more details.

#### Question 7

If I have my vehicle converted so that it runs on Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG), will the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty remain valid?

#### Answer

Although Toyota Motor Corporation Australia Limited does not recommend conversion to Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG), and accepts no responsibility or liability whatsoever in respect to engine mechanical breakdown and or accident involving LPG conversion equipment, the warrant, will continue to cover defects which arise solely as a result of faulty Toyota materials and workmanship.

Toyota New Vehicle Warranty will not cover:

- faults and defects in the parts used and the installation of the LPG conversion. The Company providing the conversion should provide this cover;
- faults and defects which may be caused by the installation and use of the conversion;
- removal of LPG conversion equipment to effect a warranty repair.

#### Question 8

Will the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty become void if I have my vehicle modified in such a way that there is no adverse affect on the vehicle?

#### **Answer**

No, the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty will continue to apply to original components of the vehicle providing they have not been altered or adjusted in any way. Also, the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty will continue to apply if your vehicle is modified with Toyota approved parts such as Toyota towbars and trailer harnesses, providing they are installed correctly. However, non-genuine Toyota modifications will not be covered by the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty.

#### Question 9

Are the tyres on my vehicle covered by the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty?

#### **Answer**

No, the tyres are covered by the tyre manufacturer's warranty. This does not mean you are deprived of your statutory rights in respect of these items. Your Toyota Dealer or cavicing dealer will be able to advise you if you have any questions on tyre warranty.

#### Question 10

What is not covered by the Toyota New Vehicle Warranty?

#### Answer

Repair and service adjustments caused by misuse (racing, rallying, overloading, etc.), negligence, water ingress, modification, alterations, tampering, disconnection, improper adjustments or repairs, accident, defects caused by the fitment of non-Toyota approved parts, add-on parts, improper maintenance and lack of Maintenance Service.

In addition, warranty does not cover Maintenance Service costs.

It should be noted that the 1,000 km and 5,000 km services as specified in this booklet are free of charge (except for the addition, where necessary, of normal maintenance items, lubricants and other materials) provided always that the vehicle has been used and operated normally.

You will be required to pay for the following Maintenance Service items, except where they are required as a result of defects in factory materials or workmanship.

- (i) Engine tune, including replacement space plugs.
- (ii) Maintenance and servicing of emission control devices.
- (iii) Cleaning or flushing of the fuel, cooling, engine, transaxle/ transmission, axle and brake systems after the 1,000 km free service.

- (iv) Replacement of any filters.
- (v) Addition to, or replacement of, lubricants.
- (vi) Addition to, or replacement of, air conditioner refrigerant.
- (vii) Wheel balancing and wheel alignment.
- (viii) Tyre wear.
- De-dusting or de-glazing of brake linings, brake disc pads, brake drums and brake discs.
- (x) Brake shoe lining, brake disc pads wear or damage.
- (xi) Brake drums and brake disc wear.
- (xii) Adjustment of clutch and brakes.
- (xiii) The removal of body rattles which are a result of normal operation and not caused by a manufacturing defect.
- (xiv) Door, hood or hatch lock adjustments.

- (xv) Chipped glass or breakage.
- (xvi) Repair/rectification of paint and panel damage.
- (xvii) Repair/replacement of trim and appearance items.
- (xviii) Battery recharging.

#### Question 11

What is the most important thing for me to do after taking delivery of my new vehicle?

#### **Answer**

It is most important to you and to Toyota that you, thoroughly check your vehicle and ensure that it meets with your satisfaction. Any problems which you detect, particularly those that may affect your warranty, should be brought to the attention of your Toyota Dealer at or before the 1,000 km first service.

#### Question 12

Should I keep my vehicle in the service care of my Toyota Dealer Network?

#### **Answer**

Yes. Of course it is your choice, however, we strongly recommend that during your ownership of your Toyota you retain the expert and professional technical services which only your Toyota Dealer can offer. The services that your Toyota Dealer can offer, such as the use of genuine Toyota parts and accessories, and technicians who are trained in the latest technological advances built into your Toyota, will ensure that your Toyota is serviced to the highest possible standard.

Toyota Dealers can also maintain the service history of your Toyota, and recommend when service is required based on your driving conditions.

#### Question 13

What if I am travelling or planning to travel and I need Maintenance Service or Warranty Repair—what do I do?

#### **Answer**

You can visit any Toyota Dealer in Australia as all Toyota Dealers are authorised and equipped to satisfy your service needs. For the nearest Toyota Dealer, see the "Toyota Dealer Directory" in this booklet.

#### Question 14

What about fluid additives like coolant additives, fuel additives, etc.?

#### Answer

Toyota recommends genuine parts for all applications of such additives where it considers it relevant and where the product has been designed for the purpose to suit the particular vehicle. Please read this booklet and the accompanying Owner's Manual for more details in this legard.

#### Question 15

What about fuel containing Ethanol?

#### Answer

Toyota approves the use of petrol with an ethanol content up to a limit of 10%.

Toyota will **not** cover failures or faults due to vehicle operation on petrol with an ethanol content greater than 10%.

### **Toyota's Lubricants and Coolant**

It is essential that Toyota's approved lubricants and coolant be used when replacing them in Toyota vehicles. When your vehicle was being designed, great care was taken by Toyota engineers in selecting lubricants and coolant for your vehicle. They are the product of extensive research and development and have been designed to provide maximum performance and protection when replaced according to the "Toyota Maintenance Schedule". Toyota's approved lubricants and coolant are specified in your Owner's Manual.

The use of non-genuine additives with Toyota's approved lubricants and coolant is not recommended. Then use is unnecessary; they will not only increase maintenance costs but they may also be detrimental to the operation of your vehicle.

#### **Engine Oil**

To ensure continued efficiency and long life of your Toyota's engine, the engine oil must be kept at the correct level and changed according to the "Toyota Maintenance Schedule" in this booklet.

See "Checking the engine oil level" in your Owner's Manual for further information. This requirement is seential on all Toyota engines.

#### WARNING - Oil Thickening Diesel Engines

Oil thickening is a phenomenon which occurs when particles of unburnt fuel and combustion by-products cause a build-up of carbon (called soot) in the engine oil forming a jelly type substance.

This phenomenon may result in serious engine damage due to components being starved of lubricating oil.

# Maintenance of your Toyota

Oil thickening may occur when engine oil change intervals are exceeded, and is more prevalent when cold temperatures, short running and low oil level conditions are experienced. High speed wide open throttle driving conditions may also cause oil thickening.

It is therefore essential that the engine oil in diesel engines be changed according to the "Toyota Maintenance Schedule" in this booklet.

#### **NOTICE**

To prevent possible harm to the engine, always replace engine oil with Toyota's approved engine oil according to the "Toyota Maintenance Schedule".

#### **Engine Coolant**

Your engine cooling system must contain ethylene-glycol based antifreeze containing anticorrosive.

Ethylene-glycol antifreeze coolant containing anticorrosive is the type of coolant your new Toyota was delivered with in addition to providing antifreeze protection reventing subsequent damage to the cooling system as a result of freezing, the coolant also protects the cooling system components from corrosion.

hen replacing coolant, it is essential that all existing coolant be thoroughly flushed from the system (includes engine, radiator, heater and hoses) and Toyota's approved coolant added together with clean demineralised or distilled water.

See "Checking the engine coolant level" in your Owner's Manual for further information. Toyota's approved coolant must be used to provide maximum protection.

#### **NOTICE**

To maintain designed cooling system protection and efficiency, the mixing of Toyota's approved coolant with any other coolant or additive must not occur.

Use only clean demineralised or distilled water to fill the cooling system.

Do not use alcohol type antifreeze or plain water alone.

Whenever coolant is replaced, the system must be thoroughly flushed as described in the applicable Toyota Repair Manual.

#### **Your Toyota's Identification**

The Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) is the primary identifier for your Toyota vehicle. It is stamped on the engine compartment bulkhead and on the portion of the vehicle's frame that lies within the right hand side (driver's side) front wheel arch.

The manufacturer's plate also contains the VIN and other model data such as the date of manufacture. It is located in the engine compartment.

Date of manufacture, hereinafter called the "Built Date", means the calendar month and year in which the body shell and power train sub-assemblies are conjoined and the vehicle is driven or moved from the production line.

The VIN, built date and other model data are also recorded on the inside front cover of this booklet.

For more information, see "Your Toyota's identification" in the Owner's Manual.

# Maintenance of your Toyota

#### **Checks Recommended At Least Weekly**

In addition to the periodic maintenance specified in the "Toyota Maintenance Schedule", the following items should be checked at least weekly.

For information on how to check these items, see "Do-it-yourself maintenance" and "Operation of instruments and controls" in the Owner's Manual.

#### Checks

- Engine coolant level
- Engine oil level
- Tyre pressure (when cold), including spare
- · Windscreen washer fluid level
- Operation of air conditioner for at least five minutes
- Operation of horn, all exterior and interior lights and service reminder indicators
- Vehicle exterior (See "Corrosion Prevention and Appearance Care" in the Owner's Manual for more information)

# **Driving Through Deep Water, Mud or Sand**

Items such as those following, require daily service when you drive through deep water, mud or sand:

- Brake lines and hoses
- Brake linings/drums and brake pads/discs
- Engine air filter

Front and rear differential oil

- Steering linkage
- · Transfer oil
- · Transmission fluid or oil
- Wheel bearings
- Propeller shafts and drive shafts

# Maintenance of your Toyota

#### **NOTICE**

Avoid driving through water that may enter the engine compartment. Water entering the engine compartment may enter the engine air intake and other components causing serious damage and or the engine to stop and not restart.

Should you need to drive through deep water, first ascertain that the depth of the water is not above the bottom of the front bumper bar and that the surface of the ground under the water is firm and even with no deep holes, then you can proceed slowly in low gear.

If the water level is deeper than above, it is advisable to wait until the water level has dropped or to find another crossing.

If your Toyota is caught in a flood and is submerged over the engine, do not start it or have it towed in a manner that may cause damage or unsafe operation. Water may have entered the engine, transmission, differential and other assemblies. Before your Toyota can be started and driven again, each assembly must be checked and serviced, otherwise, serious damage may occur.

For additional information on driving and towing your Toyota, see the vehicle's "Owner's Manual".

# Additional Maintenance Recommended by Your Toyota Dealer

In addition to the maintenance recommended by Toyota, your Dealer may recommend maintenance to ensure the continued efficiency and reliability of your Toyota according to your particular operating conditions. This maintenance may include:

- · Adjustment of valve clearance
- · Headlight realignment
- · Replacement of wiper blades
- · Brake system inspection
- Balance and rotation of wheels
- Wheel alignment
- Leak test and regas of air conditioner system
- Other maintenance or service work as recommended by your Toyota Dealer

### **Determining the Proper Maintenance Interval**

The operating conditions of your Toyota determine the maintenance interval as shown below. Use the odometer or time interval whichever occurs first, to determine when maintenance is due.

In certain circumstances, your Toyota may require more frequent maintenance than that specified.

Your Toyota Dealer will be able to help you determine the appropriate maintenance for your Toyota according to your operating conditions.

# Maintenance of your Toyota

#### UZJ100, HDJ100 Models

#### 5,000 km or 3 Months Intervals

Use 5,000 km or 3 months intervals, and the corresponding "Service" vouchers in this booklet, if you frequently operate your Toyota under any of the following severe conditions:

- Operating on rough, muddy or snow-melted roads.
- Operating on dusty roads.
- Repeated short trips less than 8 km and outside temperature remains below freezing.
- Towing a trailer, using a camper or car top carrier.
- Extensive idling and or low speed driving for a long distance such as police cars, taxis or door-to-door calls.

If you occasionally operate your Toyota under any of the above conditions, you need only perform maintenance every 10,000 km or 6 months.

#### 10,000 km or 6 Months Intervals

Use 10,000 km or 6 months intervals, and the corresponding "Service" vouchers in this booklet, if you operate your Toyota under conditions other than those listed above

# FZJ78/79, HZJ78/79/105, HDJ78/79 Models 5,000 km or 3 Months Intervals

Corresponding "Service" vouchers in this booklet, regardless of the operating conditions.

# Maintenance of your Toyota

### Following the Toyota Maintenance Schedule

The "Toyota Maintenance Schedule" is an easy-to-use quick reference for the maintenance requirements of your Toyota. It identifies the maintenance required at each kilometres interval and corresponding time interval, and it also indicates the maintenance operations required as follows:

I = Inspect and correct or replace as necessary

 $\mathbf{R} = \text{Replace}$ 

T = Tighten

L = Lubricate

 $\mathbf{A} = Adjust$ 

The information in the "Toyota Maintenance Senedule" is replicated in the corresponding "Service" wouchers in this booklet.

Maintenance beyond the last kilometres or time interval specified in the schedule should continue to be performed at the same intervals.

# **Determining Additional Maintenance for Severe Operating Conditions**

Certain items in the schedule require more frequent maintenance when your Toyota is operated under severe conditions. The intervals at which this maintenance should occur for these items is indicated by the following bracketed maintenance operations:

(I) = Inspect and correct or replace as necessary

(R) = Replace

(L) = Lubricate

(T) = Tighten

The maintenance schedule items requiring more frequent maintenance specific to each severe operating condition are as follows:

# Operating on Rough, Muddy or Snow-Melted Roads:

- · Inspect parking brake linings and drums
- · Inspect brake pads and discs
- Inspect brake pipes and hoses
- Inspect ball joints and dust covers (UZJ100, HDJ100 models)
- · Lubricate propeller shaft
- Inspect tightness of propeller shaft bolts
- Inspect steering wheel, linkage and steering gearbox oil
- Inspect drive shaft boots (UZJ100, HDJ100 models)
- Inspect front and rear suspensions
- Inspect tightness of chassis and body bolts and nuts

#### **Operating on Dusty Roads:**

- Replace engine oil and engine oil filter
- · Inspect air filter
- Inspect parking brake linings and drums
- Inspect brake pads and discs
  - Lubricate propeller shaft

Inspect tightness of propeller shaft bolts

- Replace automatic transmission fluid
- Replace manual transmission oil
- Replace transfer oil
- Replace front and rear differential oil
